YARN

Lion Brand Heartland (5 oz / 142 g / 251 yds) or a similar worsted yarn (weight 4)

Adult - 3.5 oz / 100 g / 176 yds

Child - 3.2 oz / 91 g / 161 yds

Toddler - 2.6 oz / 74 g / 131 yds

TOOLS

6mm (J) crochet hook

5.5mm (I) crochet hook

Measuring tape

Scissors

Darning needle

Ch - Chain

St(s) - Stitches

SC - Single Crochet

HDC - Half Double Crochet

FPDC - Front Post Double Crochet

BPDC - Back Post Double Crochet

Puff St [tutorial](#) - *YO, insert hook, pull up loop*, repeat *to* two more times, YO, pull through 6 loops on hook, YO, pull through last 2 loops on hook

Slst - Slip Stitch

Sk - Skip

St-sp - Space between two sts (in-between the posts)

Ch-sp - Chain Space

Rnd - Round

* * - Repeat what is in-between asterisks

[] - Number of sts for that Row/Rnd

Beg - Beginning

FO - Fasten Off

W / L - Width / Length

CONSTRUCTION

This beanie is worked from the top of the hat to the bottom (body to brim) in joined rounds. The body will be wide and loose to achieve slight slouching and then will taper at the brim for a nice, snug fit.

SIZING + MEASUREMENTS

SIZE	ADULT	YOUTH	TODDLER
FITS HEAD CIRCUMFERENCE	21-23" (53.5-58.5cm)	20-21" (51-53.5 cm)	18-19" (45.7-48.3 cm)
FINAL MEASUREMENTS	9.25"L x 9.75"W (23.5 x 25 cm)	8.75"L x 9"W (22.3 x 23 cm)	8"L x 8.25"W (20.3 x 21 cm)

IMPORTANT NOTES BEFORE YOU START

- I like to break the rules! Pay close attention to the steps and bulleted notes as you work.
- The beginning Ch does not count as a st until you reach the brim.
- If there is a number after the st, make that st in the next number of sts (DC 2 - make a DC in the next two sts).
- If there is a number before the st, make that number of sts in the next st (2DC - make two DC in the next st).
- The Puff Sts go in the St-sp, meaning between two sts (between the posts).
- The first Puff St should be made after the beg Ch1 and before the first HDC throughout.
- Beanies will be tugged and pulled when taking on and off, so don't be afraid to give a gentle tug on your beanie to relax and set those sts in place, or better yet, give it a nice steam block when finished!



| ADULT |

BODY

❖ Use the 6mm (J) crochet hook

Rnd 1: Make a magic circle; Ch1, 8 HDC in magic circle, join with Slst in the top of the first HDC - [8 HDC]

Rnd 2: (Puff St, Ch1) twice in each St-sp around, join with Slst in Ch-sp after the first Puff st - [16 Puff Sts]

- The first Puff St should be made after the beg Ch1 and before the first HDC here and throughout.

Rnd 3: Ch1, 2HDC in each Ch-sp around, join with Slst in the top of the first HDC - [32 HDC]

Rnd 4: *(Puff St, Ch1) twice in St-sp, Sk 2 sts*, repeat *to* around, join with Slst in Ch-sp after the first Puff st - [32 Puff Sts]

Check gauge = approx. 4.25" W (10.8cm)

Rnd 5: Ch1, 2HDC in each Ch-sp around, join with Slst in the top of the first HDC - [64 HDC]

Rnd 6: *Puff St in St-sp, Ch1, Sk 2 sts*, repeat *to* around, join with Slst in the Ch-sp after the first Puff st - [32 Puff Sts]

Rnds 7-16: Repeat Rnds 5 & 6

Rnd 17: Ch1, 2SC in each Ch-sp around, join with Slst in the top of the first SC - [64 SC]

Check gauge = approx. 7"L x 10"W (17.8 x 25.4cm)

BRIM

❖ Switch to 5.5mm (I) crochet hook

Rnds 18-23: Ch2 (counts as first BPDC), *FPDC, BPDC*, repeat *to* around - end with a FPDC, join with Slst in the top of beg Ch2 - [64 sts]

- For the join in the last Rnd, I like to join in the first FPDC made. It creates a tighter, more secure join.

FO - weave in those ends!

| YOUTH |

BODY

❖ Use the 6mm (J) crochet hook

Rnd 1: Make a magic circle; Ch1, 8 HDC in magic circle, join with Slst in the top of the first HDC - [8 HDC]

Rnd 2: Puff St in St-sp, Ch1, *(Puff St, Ch1) twice in St-sp*, repeat *to* around, join with Slst in Ch-sp after the first Puff st - [15 Puff Sts]

- The first Puff St should be made after the beg Ch1 and before the first HDC here and throughout.

Rnd 3: Ch1, 2HDC in each Ch-sp around, join with Slst in the top of the first HDC - [30 HDC]

Rnd 4: *(Puff St, Ch1) twice in St-sp, Sk 2 sts*, repeat *to* around, join with Slst in Ch-sp after the first Puff st - [30 Puff Sts]

Check gauge = approx. 4" W (10.1 cm)

Rnd 5: Ch1, 2HDC in each Ch-sp around, join with Slst in the top of the first HDC - [60 HDC]

Rnd 6: *Puff St in St-sp, Ch1, Sk 2 sts*, repeat *to* around, join with Slst in the Ch-sp after the first Puff st - [30 Puff Sts]

Rnds 7-16: Repeat Rnds 5 & 6

Rnd 17: Ch1, 2SC in each Ch-sp around, join with Slst in the top of the first SC - [64 SC]

Check gauge = approx. 6.75"L x 9"W (17.2 x 22.9cm)

BRIM

❖ Switch to 5.5mm (I) crochet hook

Rnds 18-22: Ch2 (counts as first BPDC), *FPDC, BPDC*, repeat *to* around - end with a FPDC, join with Slst in the top of beg Ch2 - [60 sts]

- For the join in the last Rnd, I like to join in the first FPDC made. It creates a tighter, more secure join.

FO - weave in those ends!

| TODDLER |

BODY

❖ Use the 5.5mm (I) crochet hook

Rnd 1: Make a magic circle; Ch1, 7 HDC in magic circle, join with Slst in the top of the first HDC - [7 HDC]

Rnd 2: (Puff St, Ch1) twice in each St-sp around, join with Slst in Ch-sp after the first Puff st - [14 Puff Sts]

- The first Puff St should be made after the beg Ch1 and before the first HDC here and throughout.

Rnd 3: Ch1, 2HDC in each Ch-sp around, join with Slst in the top of the first HDC - [28 HDC]

Rnd 4: *(Puff St, Ch1) twice in St-sp, Sk 2 sts*, repeat *to* around, join with Slst in Ch-sp after the first Puff st - [28 Puff Sts]

Check gauge = approx. 3.75" W (9.5cm)

Rnd 5: Ch1, 2HDC in each Ch-sp around, join with Slst in the top of the first HDC - [56 HDC]

Rnd 6: *Puff St in St-sp, Ch1, Sk 2 sts*, repeat *to* around, join with Slst in the Ch-sp after the first Puff st - [28 Puff Sts]

Rnds 7-14: Repeat Rnds 5 & 6

Rnd 15: Ch1, 2SC in each Ch-sp around, join with Slst in the top of the first SC - [56 SC]

Check gauge = approx. 6"L x 8.25"W (15.2 x 21cm)

BRIM

❖ Switch to 5.5mm (I) crochet hook

Rnds 16-20: Ch2 (counts as first BPDC), *FPDC, BPDC*, repeat *to* around - end with a FPDC, join with Slst in the top of beg Ch2 - [56 sts]

- For the join in the last Rnd, I like to join in the first FPDC made. It creates a tighter, more secure join.

FO - weave in those ends!
